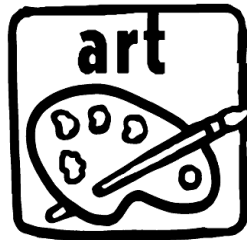
#### Primary Colours Art Exhibition 2012
